- Pastor Katrina will ask if meals would be a comfort as situations arise.
- Direct contact is made to arrange details (delivery logistics, restaurant preferences, dietary needs, etc.)
- Participants receive a sign-up list with the basic information and dates. Options include preparing a home-cooked meal for the scheduled date, covering a meal delivery via DoorDash or Grubhub, or giving a gift card to a local restaurant (consider partnering with someone to share the cost of a gift card).

Expanding the list of willing participants helps to spread the care among us, and we want to make clear that helping does not necessarily involve turning on your oven! There is also no expectation to help each time. Whether once a month or once a year, every bit helps and is appreciated. As always, reaching out to one another directly is a blessing, too!
